AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles Insurance  
(Third-party Risks) Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 4.

[29th March, 1943.]

*Commencement.*

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 4. hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 2 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the following for the definition of "insurer" therein :—

“ ‘insurer’ means—

- (a) an assurance company in whose case the requirements of the Assurance Companies Ordinance, 1943, with respect to deposits and guarantees by assurance companies are complied with or an assurance company which is exempted from such requirements by virtue of an order made under sections 37 or 38 of that Ordinance ;
- (b) a person or body of persons carrying on in the Colony the business of giving security of a like kind who or which has deposited and keeps deposited with the Accountant General the sum of \$48,000 or approved securities to the like amount in respect of that business and is approved by the Governor ;”.

Passed in Council this nineteenth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
