AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 4.

Enactment.

NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short-title and Construction. Insurance (Third-party Risks) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, Ch. 16. No. 4 and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is Principal hereby amended by substituting the words "driving permit" Ordinance for the word "licence" wherever the latter word occurs in the said subsection.

Passed in Council this twenty-sixth day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-six.
