ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with

Ch. 16. No. 4.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles  
Insurance (Third-party Risks) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946,  
and shall be read and construed as one with the Motor Vehicles  
Insurance (Third-party Risks) Ordinance, hereinafter referred  
to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "driving permit" for the word "licence" wherever the latter word occurs in the said subsection.
