AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 4.

[Assented to 17th March, 1978]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles In- Short title
Insurance (Third-Party Risks) (Amendment) Act, 1978.

Section 3 of
the Ordinance
amended

2. Section 3(2) of the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") is amended by substituting the words "five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for six months" for the words "two hundred and forty dollars or to imprisonment for three months".

Section 18 of
the Ordinance
amended

3. Section 18 of the Ordinance is amended—

(a) by renumbering subsection (1), as subsection (2), by deleting the proviso and the words "and if he fails so to do he shall be guilty of an offence".

(b) by inserting the following new subsections therein in numerical order—

"(1) A person who drives or is in charge of a motor vehicle on any road shall have either on his person or in the motor vehicle his certificate for production as required under subsection (2).

(3) Any person who fails to comply with the requirements of either subsection (1) or subsection (2) is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for six months.";

(c) by renumbering subsection (2) as subsection (4);

(d) by renumbering subsection (3) as subsection (5) and by deleting the proviso thereto, and the words "and if he fails so to do he shall be guilty of an offence";

(e) by renumbering subsection (4) as subsection (6) and by—

(i) deleting "produce his certificate" and substituting "certificate",

(ii) deleting "produce for examination".
