REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO Act No. 44 of 1981

An Act to amend the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Act, Ch. 48:51.

[Assented to 24th December, 1981]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles short title Insurance (Third-Party Risks) (Amendment) Act, 1981.

Act amended Ch. 48:51

2. Section 2 of the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third-Party Risks) Act is amended by substituting the following for the definition of "insurer"—

""insurer" means a company registered to carry on insurance business in Trinidad and Tobago and includes an underwriter and an association of underwriters, but does not include an insurance agent as such and, where an insurance agent is also an insurer, it does not refer to that part of his business done as an insurance agent;".
