AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Corporations
(Pensions) Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 13.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Cor- Short title and

as the Principal Ordinance.

Subsection (5)
of section 22 of
the Principal

replaced.

2. (1) Subsection (5) of section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(5) For the purposes of this section, the expression “year of effective service” means a period of 250 days’ work performed within one calendar year.”

(2) In relation to persons who are temporary employees of the Corporation on the coming into force of this Ordinance, the interpretation of the expression “year of effective service” given by this section shall apply to service before as well as after the coming into force of this Ordinance.
