2. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Computation  
of pensions,  
&c., on what  
emoluments to  
be based

14. For the purpose of computing the amount of an officer's pension, or gratuity, or allowance—

- (a) in the case of an officer who has held one office for a period of three years immediately preceding the date of his retirement, the full pensionable emoluments payable to him at that date in respect of that office shall be taken;
- (b) in the case of an officer who at any time during such period of three years has been transferred from one office to another, but whose pensionable emoluments have not been changed by reason of such transfer or transfers, the full pensionable emoluments payable to him at the date of his retirement in respect of the office held by him shall be taken;
- (c) in other cases one-third of the aggregate pensionable emoluments payable to the officer in respect of his service during the said three years shall be taken:

Provided that—

- (i) if such one-third is less than the full pensionable emoluments which were payable to him at the date of his transfer within such period of three years the Council may grant him a pension calculated on the full pensionable emoluments payable to him at that date; and
- (ii) if such one-third is less than the full pensionable emoluments which would have been enjoyed by him at the date of his retirement, if he had continued to hold any office from which he had been transferred

at any time during such period of three years, and had received all increments which in the opinion of the Council, would have been granted to him, the full pensionable emoluments which would have been so payable to him shall be taken; and

- (iii) for the purposes of calculating pensionable emoluments under this paragraph the officer shall be deemed to have been on duty on full pensionable emoluments throughout the said three years."
