AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Corporations
(Pensions) Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 13.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Corpora-
tions (Pensions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall
be read as one with the Municipal Corporations (Pensions)
Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 21 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the words and commas “, and who has served for not less than five years,” occurring immediately after the word “agreement” in the second line of subsection (1) thereof; and
- (b) by substituting the words “commuted pension gratuity” for the words “commuted pensionable gratuity” wherever they occur in the said section.

3. Subsection (4) of section 22 of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, is hereby amended by substituting the words “the greater” for the word “less” occurring in the twelfth line thereof.
