AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for computing the pension, gratuities and other allowances payable to certain officers of the San Fernando Corporation, and to declare certain offices pensionable.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Corporation Pensions (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1960.

Short title

Interpretation.

2. In this Ordinance—

Ch. 39. No. 7.

“Corporation” has the meaning assigned to it by the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance;

“Schedule” means the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Certain service to be taken into account as pensionable service
Ch. 39. No. 13.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Ordinance, in computing the pension, gratuity or other allowance to be paid to any person whose name is set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Ordinance in respect of his service under the Corporation, service by such person in any office under the Corporation between the date specified in the said Part I opposite to the name of such person and the commencement of this Ordinance shall be taken into account as service in a pensionable office.

Certain offices declared to be pensionable offices.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Municipal Corporations (Pensions) Ordinance, the offices under the Corporation set out in the second column of Part II of the Schedule to this Ordinance, being offices in the departments respectively set out in the first column of the said Part II, are hereby declared to be pensionable offices, and any person substantively appointed to any of the said offices shall be deemed to be an officer for all the purposes of that Ordinance.
