

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petty Civil Courts Ordinance, 1911.

[22nd December, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petty Civil Short title. Courts (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1921.

2. Section 7 of the Petty Civil Courts Ordinance, 1911, Judges of the Courts. is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

7. The magistrates shall be the judges of the Courts in their respective districts. In the magisterial district of St. George West the magistrate and the assistant magistrate shall be the judges of the courts.
