AN ORDINANCE to amend the Mariners Club Ordinance,  
1954, No. 8 of 1954.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the  
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mariners Club  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be read as one with  
the Mariners Club Ordinance, 1954, hereinafter referred to as  
the Principal Ordinance.

2. (1) Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by inserting immediately after the word "vested" occurring in subsection (3) thereof the words "or which may hereafter be vested" and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (4):—

"(4) It shall be lawful for the Board from time to time—

- (a) to borrow money and give as security for the loan a mortgage or charge on all or any of the personal property vested or which may hereafter be vested in them;
- (b) with the consent in writing of the Governor, but not otherwise, to borrow money and give as security for the loan a mortgage or charge on all or any of the real property vested or which may hereafter be vested in them."

(2) The marginal note to section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "acquire" appearing therein the words "deal with".
