ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the  
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Marriage (Amend- Short title  
ment) Ordinance, 1952 and shall be read as one with the  
Marriage Ordinance, as from time to time amended, which Ch. 29. No. 2  
Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the  
Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

- (a) by adding immediately after the words "District Registrar" where they first appear in the section the expression "or, where the Marriage Notice Book is kept by a Warden in the capacity of District Registrar, any officer authorised in that behalf in writing by the Warden,";
- (b) by adding immediately after the words "District Registrar" where they next appear in the section the expression "or officer, as the case may be,".
