## Act No. 6 of 1965

[L.S.]

AN ACT to amend the Post Office Savings Bank  
Ordinance.

[Assented to 6th March, 1965]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

## Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Post Office Savings Bank (Amendment) Act, 1965.

## Section 9 of Ordinance amended

2. Section 9 of the Post Office Savings Bank Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") is amended—

(a) by repealing subsection (1) thereof and replacing it as follows:—

"9. (1) Interest shall be payable on deposit at such rate per centum per annum as may be fixed from time to time by the Governor-General, but no change of rate shall have effect unless notice of the change has been given by publication in the *Gazette*."

(b) by substituting in subsection (2) thereof, the words "one dollar" for the words "five dollars" wherever those words occur therein;

(c) by repealing subsection (3) thereof.

## Section 11 (1) amended

3. Subsection (1) of section 11 of the Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "the Governor-General" for the words "the Governor in Council or in the case of moneys remitted to London for investments by the Secretary of State" occurring therein.
