AN ACT to amend the Praedial Larceny Prevention
Act, 1963.

[Assented to 18th June, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Praedial Larceny ^{Short title}
Prevention (Amendment) Act, 1976.

2. Section 3 of the Praedial Larceny Prevention Act, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by renumbering subsections (2) and (3) thereof as subsections (4) and (5) and by inserting the following new subsections therein:—

" (2) A person who in any place other than a public market sells or otherwise disposes of agricultural produce of the value of one hundred dollars or more shall at the time of delivery of the agricultural produce give a signed memorandum of sale or delivery to the purchaser or other person obtaining possession or custody of the agricultural produce setting out the particulars required to be specified therein by subsection (1).

(3) A person who fails to comply with the provisions of subsection (2) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of two thousand five hundred dollars."

3. Section 4(2) of the Act is amended by substituting for the words "fifty dollars" at the end thereof, the words "five hundred dollars".

4. Section 7 of the Act is amended by renumbering the section as section 7(1) and by adding the following new subsection thereto:—

" (2) A person who on being required to produce a memorandum of sale or delivery under subsection (1) in respect of agricultural produce of the value of one hundred dollars or more fails to produce the memorandum of sale or delivery is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of two thousand five hundred dollars."
