AN ORDINANCE to amend the Provident Fund
Ordinance, 1930.

[9th May, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Provident Fund Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be read as one Construction.
with the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, hereinafter called (19-1930.)
the Principal Ordinance.

2. The definition of "Employee" in section 2 of the Definition of
Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the "Employee."
words "and includes any person", as they appear in the
third and fourth lines of such definition.

3. Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby renumbered 24 (1), and the following shall be inserted as sub-section (2) of the said section:—

(2) The Treasurer may, with the approval of a depositor, apply both the compulsory deposits and the bonuses accruing to such depositor towards the effecting of assurance on his life in the manner to be designated by Regulations made hereunder.

4. Paragraph (6) of section 25 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby renumbered (7), and the following shall be inserted as paragraph (6) of the said section:

“(6) As to the effecting of assurances on the life of depositors; and”
and the word “and” at the end of paragraph (5) of the said section is hereby deleted.
