AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Provident
Fund Ordinance, 1930.

[9th December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Provident Fund Short title.
(Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be read as
one with the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, hereinafter (19-1930.)
called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Repeal and
repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:— re-enactment

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by deleting the words "the commencement of this Ordinance" wheresoever they occur and in lieu thereof shall be inserted the words "the date fixed in accordance with the last preceding section".

(2) by deleting the last paragraph of sub-section (2) and by inserting the following as sub-section (3):—

(3) Employees in the service of the Government prior to the date fixed in accordance with the last preceding section shall not be compellable to become depositors, but every such employee who elects to become a depositor shall exercise his option by notice in writing to the Treasurer not later than such subsequent date as may be fixed by the Governor by the same or any other Proclamation.
