AN ORDINANCE to amend the Provident Fund  
Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 9.

[16th September, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Provident Short title.  
Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be construed Construction.  
as one with the Provident Fund Ordinance, hereinafter Ch. 9. No. 9.  
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into  
force on the 12th day of February, 1937.

Section 7 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

2. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a colon for the full stop at the end thereof and by adding immediately thereafter the following :—

“ Provided that this section shall not apply in the case of a depositor who voluntarily retires from the office of wardman or attendant at the Chacachacare Leper Asylum having completed not less than ten years continuous service as a wardman or attendant aforesaid immediately prior to his retirement ”.

Section 20 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

3. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a semi-colon for the full stop at the end thereof and by adding immediately thereafter the following :—

“ (iv) to a depositor who voluntarily retires from the office of wardman or attendant at the Chacachacare Leper Asylum having completed not less than ten years continuous service as a wardman or attendant aforesaid immediately prior to his retirement ”.

Section 21 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

4. Subsection (1) of section 21 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a semi-colon for the full stop at the end thereof and by adding the following paragraph :—

“ (e) to a depositor who voluntarily retires from the office of wardman or attendant at the Chacachacare Leper Asylum having completed not less than ten years continuous service as a wardman or attendant aforesaid immediately prior to his retirement ”.
