AN ORDINANCE to amend the Provident Fund Ordinance,

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Provident Fund
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be read as one with
the Provident Fund Ordinance.

2. Section 21 of the Provident Fund Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by adding the following proviso at the end of paragraph (d) of subsection (1) :—

“Provided further that, in the case of a depositor referred to in section 17 of this Ordinance, where the gratuity under this subsection is less than the amount which the legal personal representative or dependant would have received under the Pensions laws if the depositor had continued to be the holder of a non-pensionable post, there may be paid to the nominee or legal personal representative or dependant of the deceased depositor in lieu of a gratuity under this section an amount not exceeding nine months’ wages which the deceased depositor had received immediately prior to his becoming a depositor.” ;

(b) by adding the following subsection at the end thereof :—

(6) In this section, “Pensions laws” means the Pensions Ordinance and the regulations thereunder, and any Ordinances or regulations from time to time amending or replacing the same.
