AN ACT to amend the Provident Fund Ordinance, Ch. 9.
No. 9.

[Assented to 13th September, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Provident Fund ^{Short title} (Amendment) Act, 1966.

2. Section 19 of the Provident Fund Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by re-numbering the same as subsection (1) thereof; and
- (b) by adding the following as subsection (2);
 - “(2) For the purposes of subsection (1) a person shall not be taken to have been without wages from the funds of Trinidad and Tobago if such person—
 - (a) has been granted leave of absence without pay for a period not exceeding three years for the purpose of engaging in trade union business approved by the Governor-General; and
 - (b) deposits a sum equivalent to the bonus required by section 20 to be transferred by the Comptroller of Accounts from general revenue to the account of such person.”.
