AN ORDINANCE to amend the Prisons Ordinance,
No. 27.

[24th December, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prisons (Amend- Short Title,
ment) Ordinance, 1917.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 5 of Tobago
the Prisons Ordinance (No. 27), any person sentenced on District
summary conviction in Tobago to imprisonment with or Prison.
without hard labour may be imprisoned in a District Prison
in Tobago for the full term to which he is sentenced.
