AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Holidays
Ordinance, Cap. 288.

[29th June, 1939.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays ^{Short title.}
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1939.

Schedule to
Cap. 288
amended.

2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :—

Empire Day—that is the 24th of May, or if that day falls on a Sunday, the next following Monday.

Discovery Day—that is the first Monday in August.

Boxing Day—that is the day after Christmas Day, but if Christmas Day falls either on a Saturday or a Sunday, then the next following Monday or Tuesday respectively shall be a public holiday.

Passed in Council this sixteenth day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
