AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance,
Ch. 42. No. 1.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be read as one with
the Public Holidays Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the
Principal Ordinance.

Short Title.

Ch. 42. No. 1.

Schedule to
Principal Ordinance amended.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the public holiday referred to therein as "Empire Day" the following:

"May Day—that is the 1st day of May, or if that day falls on a Sunday, the next following Monday."

Passed in Council this eighth day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty.
