AN ACT to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance,
Ch. 42. No. 1.

[Assented to 30th August, 1962]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows: —

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amend- ^{Short title}
ment) Act, 1962.

2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after the public holiday referred therein as "Discovery Day" the following :

"Independence Day—that is the 31st day of August"
