AN ACT to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance, Ch. 42.  
No. 1.

[Assented to 28th April, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by <sup>Enactment.</sup> and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays <sup>Short title.</sup> (Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is amended by substituting for the public holiday referred to therein as "May Day" the following:

"Labour Day—that is the 19th day of June, or if that day falls on a Sunday, the next following Monday."
