MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE  
CIVIL SERVICE ACT

THE CIVIL SERVICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1982

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Service (Amendment) Regulations, 1982. <sup>Citation</sup>

2. Regulation 16 of the Civil Service Regulations is amended by <sup>Regulation</sup> repealing and replacing subregulation (1) as follows:— <sup>16 amended</sup>

“ (1) The minimum age of recruitment of officers shall be seventeen years, and, except where otherwise specified, the maximum age of recruitment or re-employment of officers shall be forty-five years. However, a person who has attained the age of forty-five years and who has previous service, whether pensionable or non-pensionable which under section 10(2) of the Pensions Act may be deemed to count for pension purposes may, notwithstanding his age, be recruited to or re-employed in the Civil Service if upon attaining the age of compulsory retirement he would qualify, in terms of length of service, for a pension.”
