THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT, CHAP. 23:01

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT THE CIVIL SERVICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Service (Amend-Citation ment) Regulations, 1984.
- 2. The Civil Service Regulations are amended by repealing and G.N. No. 122 replacing regulation 16(1) and (2) as follows—
 - "Age of recruitment
- (1) The minimum age of recruitment of officers shall be seventeen years, and, except where otherwise specified, the maximum age of recruitment or re-employment of officers shall be fifty years. However, a person who has attained the age of fifty years and who has previous service, whether pensionable or non-pensionable which under section 10(2) of the Pensions Act may be deemed to count for pension purposes may, notwithstanding his age, be recruited to
- Pensions Act may be deemed to count for pension purposes may, notwithstanding his age, be recruited to or re-employed in the Civil Service if upon attaining the age of compulsory retirement he would qualify, in terms of length of service, for a pension.
 - (2) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), but subject to subregulation (3), persons over the age of fifty years may be recruited on contract for specialised work.".
- 3. These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on commencethe 16th day of February, 1984.
