REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 28 OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT

THE CIVIL SERVICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1984

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Service (Amendment) Regulations, 1984. Citation

2. The Civil Service Regulations are amended by repealing and replacing regulation 16(1) and (2) as follows— G.N. No. 122
of 1987
amended

“Age of
recruitment

Act No. 14
of 1980

(1) The minimum age of recruitment of officers shall be seventeen years, and, except where otherwise specified, the maximum age of recruitment or re-employment of officers shall be fifty years. However, a person who has attained the age of fifty years and who has previous service, whether pensionable or non-pensionable which under section 10(2) of the Pensions Act may be deemed to count for pension purposes may, notwithstanding his age, be recruited to or re-employed in the Civil Service if upon attaining the age of compulsory retirement he would qualify, in terms of length of service, for a pension.

(2) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), but subject to subregulation (3), persons over the age of fifty years may be recruited on contract for specialised work.”

3. These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on the 16th day of February, 1984. Commence-
