AN ACT to amend the Privileges and Immunities
(Diplomatic, Consular and International
Organisations) Act, Chap. 17: 01.

[Assented to 8th June, 1994]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Privileges and Immunities (Diplomatic, Consular and International Organisations) (Amendment) Act, 1994.

Chap. 17:01
amended

2. The Privileges and Immunities (Diplomatic, Consular and International Organisations) Act is amended in section 9 by inserting after subsection (2) the following new subsection:

“ (2A) An Order made under subsection (2) may confer juridical personality on the organisation, investing it with the status of a body corporate within the meaning of section 37 of the Interpretation Act.”
