REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 28
OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT

THE CIVIL SERVICE (EXTERNAL AFFAIRS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1989

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Service (External Affairs) (Amendment) Regulations, 1989. Citation

2. The Civil Service (External Affairs) Regulations are amended as follows: Amendment
of
Chap. 23:01

(a) by inserting immediately after regulation 35, the following new regulation 35A—

“Special
Housing
Allowance

35A. An officer who is not provided with accommodation by the Government in accordance with regulation 34, and is—

- (a) recruited in the country in which he is normally domiciled and owns a home; or
- (b) posted from Trinidad and Tobago to serve in a country where his spouse holds resident status or citizenship and is normally domiciled therein and owns a home,

shall be entitled to receive a Special Housing Allowance, which shall be equal to the actual monthly ownership costs namely mortgage amounts, property taxes and home insurance incurred by him or the maximum sums set out in the Schedule, whichever is less, and his monthly salary shall also be subject to a deduction of a maximum of ten per cent.”;

(b) in regulation 38, by repealing paragraph (2) and replacing it in the following manner—

“(2) Annual leave for officers posted at a Mission shall be as follows:

- (a) Foreign Service Officers—21 working days;
- (b) Members of the non-diplomatic staff—
 - (i) who have been in the Service for a period exceeding 10 years; and
 - (ii) who are in receipt of a salary either equal to or greater than that of the maximum salary range 24—21 working days;
- (c) Other non-diplomatic staff—14 working days;

- (c) in regulation 39(1) by substituting for the words, "A Foreign Service Officer" occurring in line one, the words, "A Foreign Service Officer or non-diplomatic staff entitled to annual leave under clause (b) of regulation 38(2)";
- (d) by inserting a Schedule immediately after regulation 47, as follows:

3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st January, 1976.
