AN ORDINANCE to amend the Young Offenders
Detention Ordinance, 1926.

[10th December, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Young Offenders
Detention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, and shall be
read as one with the Young Offenders Detention Ordinance,
1926, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby
amended by deleting the words "after a previous conviction
"for any offence for which he might be so sentenced, or
"after an order of detention in an Industrial School."
