Young Offenders Detention (Amendment).

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Young Offenders Detention Ordinance, Ch. 11, No. 9.

Commencement.

[14th May, 1942.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Young Offenders Detention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942.

Section 13 of
the Principal
Ordinance
repealed.

2. Section 13 of the Young Offenders Detention Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) is hereby repealed.

Section 16 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by—

- (a) deleting the words "or to be imprisoned for three months; and, if sentenced to imprisonment he shall, at the expiration of the term thereof, be brought back to the Institution" occurring at the end of subsection (1) thereof, and by replacing the comma after the word "directs" by a full stop;
- (b) deleting the words "including the time (if any) during which he was imprisoned under this section," occurring in subsection (2) thereof.
