MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 161(1) OF THE
REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT

THE REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1994

1. The Rules may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) Rules, 1994. Citation

2. The Registration Rules are amended by inserting after Rule 31A ^{Registration Rules amended}
the following:

“Expiry date of identification cards” 31B. (1) The Commission may, upon notice to be published in the *Gazette* and at least one daily newspaper—
(a) fix a date for the expiry and invalidation of all existing identification cards;
(b) extend the expiry date of identification cards issued by it, as of 22nd July, 1985, by any period that the Commission considers appropriate.

(2) In this rule ‘existing identification card’ means an identification card issued prior to 22nd July, 1985.”
