AN ACT to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Act,
1962.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1968]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court of ^{Short title}
Judicature (Amendment) Act, 1968.

2. The Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962, is amended—

- (a) by substituting the word “eleven” for the word “ten” occurring immediately before the word “Puisne” in line two of subsection (1) of section 5 thereof;
- (b) by substituting the words “no fewer than three and no more than four Justices of Appeal” for the words “three Justices of Appeal” occurring in line three of subsection (1) of section 6 thereof;
- (c) by repealing subsection (4) of section 67 thereof and replacing it by the following—

“(4) The Deputy Registrar and every Assistant Registrar shall in the exercise of his office have all and singular the like authorities, powers, duties and immunities and liabilities of the Registrar, except where otherwise provided by rules of court.”
