AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce  
Ordinance, 1921.

[8th December, 1922.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce Short title.  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1922, and shall be read as Construction.  
one with the Sale of Produce Ordinance, 1921, hereinafter 54--1921.  
called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Principal Special  
Ordinance, which reads as follows:— Sessions.

(2) The Governor may from time to time, if he thinks fit, authorize the magistrate to hold special sessions for the granting of such licences.

is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

(2) The Governor may from time to time, if he thinks fit, authorize the magistrate to hold special sessions for the granting of such licences; provided that a fee of three pounds shall be payable in respect of each application considered at any such special sessions.
