AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce Ordinance, Cap. 273.

[11th November, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

Construction.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Sale of Produce Ordinance, Cap. 273, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

Definition of "coffee."

2. Sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the following for the definition of "coffee":—

"Coffee" means coffee in pulp or cherry and raw coffee in the parchment, but not raw cleaned coffee.

Passed in Council this thirty-first day of October, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty.
