AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce Ordinance,
Cap. 273.

[24th November, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be construed Construction.
as one with the Sale of Produce Ordinance, Cap. 273,
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as Inclusion of citrus fruits in definition of "Produce."
follows:—

(1) by inserting the following definition before the
definition of "Cocoa" in section 2 (1):

"Citrus fruit" includes oranges, lemons,
limes and grape-fruit.

- (2) by substituting the words "citrus fruits" for the word "limes"—
- (a) in the definition of "Produce" in section 2 (1);
 - (b) in paragraph (a) and in sub-paragraph (i) of sub-section (1) of section 36.
