Sale of Produce (Amendment).

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce Ordinance,
Ch. 23. No. 17.

[27th August, 1942.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Sale of Produce Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the definition of "coconuts" and substituting the following definition—

"coconuts" means ripe or dry coconuts, whether husked or not husked, and includes the dry kernels of coconuts ;.

3. Section 33 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by inserting, immediately after paragraph (d), a new paragraph as follows—

(dd) no person shall sell or purchase undried kernels of coconuts ;

(b) by deleting paragraph (f) and substituting the following paragraph—

(f) the provisions of subsection (2) of section 4, section 6, subsection (4) of section 8, subsection (1) and subsection (2) paragraphs (a), (b) and (d) of section 13, and sections 16, 17, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 of this Ordinance shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to licences granted and persons licensed under this section ;.
