AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sale of Produce Ordinance,
Ch. 23. No. 17.

[6th November, 1947.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with
the Sale of Produce Ordinance as amended by the Sale of
Produce (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, which Ordinance as
so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal
Ordinance.

Section 32 of Principal Ordinance amended

2. Section 32 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by adding the words “or a person who satisfies a Magistrate that he is a *bona fide* manufacturer of preparations of licensable produce and that he purchases licensable produce solely for the purpose of such manufacture,” immediately after the words “solely for that purpose,” in the first paragraph thereof ;
- (b) by substituting the words “licensable produce” for the word “cocoa” wherever the latter word occurs in paragraph (b).

Schedule to Principal Ordinance amended

3. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the following forms for Forms F and G :—
