1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sale of Produce Short title.

“44. The provisions of section 3 and of all other sections of this Ordinance connected with the licensing and dealing in licensable produce by any person shall not apply to the Marketing Board established under the Marketing Board Ordinance, 1948.”
