A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Sale of Produce Ordinance, Ch. 23. No. 18, it is provided that the term "licensable produce" includes *inter alia* such article of produce as the Governor in Council, by proclamation, may from time to time direct to be included in such term:

And Whereas it is expedient that the article of produce "mace" should be included in the term "licensable produce":

Now, therefore, I, EDWARD BETHAM BEETHAM, Governor as aforesaid, in Executive Council, do hereby direct that the article of produce "mace" shall be included in the term "licensable produce".
