Widows' and Orphans' Pensions.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8.

Commencement.

[31st December, 1941.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1941.

Section 29 (1) (b) of Ch. 9. No. 8. amended.

2. Paragraph (b) of section 29 (1) of the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following—

(b) if retiring with a pension immediately payable to him, to remain a contributor until he has attained the age or been a contributor for the period aforesaid, paying an annual contribution which shall be calculated on the basis of his annual pension at the appropriate rate fixed by section 10 of this Ordinance (whenever such annual pension is at least four hundred and eighty dollars) or at the rate of four per centum (whenever such annual pension is less than four hundred and eighty dollars); or

Validation of certain acts.

3. All abatements made since the coming into force of the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, in respect of contributions payable on pensions of less than four hundred and eighty dollars per annum are hereby declared to have been lawfully made and are hereby validated.
