AN ORDINANCE to amend the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 8.

[29th March, 1945.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "twenty-one" for the word "eighteen" wherever it appears in the definition of "pensionable age".

Section 9 (4)
of Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Subsection (4) of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the word "twenty-one" for the word "eighteen";

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following proviso :—

" Provided that where the Governor in Council is satisfied that a child who has reached the pensionable age is by reason of infirmity of mind or body incapable of earning a livelihood, and has no sufficient means of support, he may order that the whole or any portion of the pension which—

(i) was payable to the child and would have ceased on such child attaining the pensionable age; or

(ii) would have become payable to the child in the event of the death of the widow had not such child attained the pensionable age,

shall be paid to such child for such period as he may determine."

Passed in Council this sixteenth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
