AN ORDINANCE to amend the Spirits and Spirit
Compounds Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 9.

[3rd June, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Short title.
Compounds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be read Construction.
as one with the Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 9.
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 2 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the following definition between the words "In this Ordinance" and the definition of "Comptroller" appearing at the beginning thereof:—

"bay rum" means spirits mixed with oil of bay, and any lotion or other toilet preparation sold or offered for sale as a mixture containing oil of bay or any other ingredient obtained from the bay tree ;"

Section 20 of
the Principal
Ordinance

3. Subsection (1) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "Comptroller" for the word "Governor" where it appears therein.

Section 74 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

4. Section 74 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following subsections:

(3) A permit granted under this section shall in no case continue in force beyond the ensuing 31st of December.

(4) A person to whom a permit is granted under this section at any time after the first quarter of any year shall pay three-fourths, one half, or one fourth of the annual fee according as the permit is granted in the second, third, or fourth quarter of the year respectively: Provided that the provisions of this subsection shall not apply in the case of a person who has held a permit granted under this section at any time during the twelve months immediately preceding."

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
