AN ORDINANCE to amend the Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 9.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Compounds (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance, as from time to time amended, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of section 79D of the Principal Ordinance (as enacted by section 3 of the Spirits and Spirit Compounds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952) is hereby amended by substituting the expression "section 79C" for the expression "subsection (6) of section 79".

3. Section 79G of the Principal Ordinance (as enacted by section 3 of the Spirits and Spirit Compounds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952) is hereby amended:—

(a) by substituting the following subsection for subsection (7) thereof:—

"(7) No spirits shall be removed from any licensed premises except in the presence and with the consent of an Officer and with the written authority of the Comptroller and subject to such conditions as the Comptroller may impose."

(b) by substituting the expression "subsections (2), (4), (6) and (7)" for the expression "subsections (2), (6) and (7)."
