AN ACT to amend the Spirits and Spirit Compounds
Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 9.

[*Assented to 29th December, 1967*]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by
the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Com- Short title
pounds (Amendment) Act, 1967.

2. Section 2 of the Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance is hereby amended as follows—

(a) by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical order the following definition—

“ “neutral spirits” means alcohol, or a mixture of alcohol and water, of such purity that irrespective of the method of preparation or the nature of the raw materials used, that it has no odour or flavour other than that derived from ethyl alcohol;”; and

(b) by repealing and replacing the definition of “rum” with the following—

“ “rum” means an alcoholic beverage distilled from any fermented product of the sugar cane in such a way that the beverage possesses the taste, aroma and other characteristics generally attributed to rum;”.
