AN ORDINANCE to amend the Statistics Ordinance,

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

Ch. 42. No. 11
(Laws 1951—53
Vol. 1 p. 303)

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Statistics (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Statistics Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following paragraph is hereby substituted for paragraph 3 of the Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance :—

Second Schedule to Principal Ordinance amended

“3. At any time after three days from the expiration of the time limit fixed under paragraph 1 of this Schedule the Governor in Council shall consider any such objections made by or on behalf of any persons or undertakings appearing to him to be affected, which have been received by him, and may thereafter proceed to make the Regulations, with or without amendment as he may consider expedient.”

Passed in Council this eleventh day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
