AN ACT to amend the Crown Liability and Proceedings
Act, 1966.

[Assented to 13th April, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Crown Liability and Short title
Proceedings (Amendment) Act, 1976.

2. The Crown Liability and Proceedings Act, 1966 is amended—

- (a) by substituting the word “State” for the word “Crown” wherever it occurs therein;
- (b) by repealing section 2(2)(d);
- (c) by inserting in section 2 in its appropriate alphabetical order the following new definition—

“ “the State” means the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;”.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into operation contemporaneously with the Constitution set out in the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Act, 1976.
