Act No. 6 of 1988

AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of
Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1987

[Assented to 8th April, 1988]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of short title
Appropriation) (1987) Act, 1988.

Construction of Act No. 2 of 1987

2. In this Act and in any other written law, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1987, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act passed before this or that other written law.

Increase in Heads of Expenditure

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1987, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part I.

Reduction in Heads of Expenditure

4. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1987, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part II.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads in Part II may be utilised Chap. 69:01

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1987 and unissued at the commencement of this Act, may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule.
