**Act No. 3 of 1997**

AN ACT to amend the Sugar Industry Labour  
Welfare Committee (Incorporation) Act and to  
validate things done thereunder.

*[Assented to 11th March, 1997]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sugar Industry Short title  
Labour Welfare Committee (Incorporation) (Amend-  
ment and Validation) Act, 1997.

Interpretation

Chap. 64:05

2. In this Act, “the Act” means the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Committee (Incorporation) Act.

Section 2 of the Act repealed

3. Section 2 of the Act is repealed and the following is substituted:

“Interpreta-  
tion

2. In this Act—

“the Fund” means the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund established under the Sugar Industry Special Funds Act;

“Minister” means the Minister to whom responsibility for Housing and Settlements is assigned.”.

Validation

4. All acts and things done or purported to be done by the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Committee in the exercise of powers conferred under the Act are deemed to have been lawfully and validly done.
