AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sugar Industry Special
Funds Ordinance, Ch. 23. No. 14.

[23rd December, 1954.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with Enactment
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Industry Short title
Special Funds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be
read as one with the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance, Ch. 23. No. 14
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Transfer of
moneys from

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Principal Ordinance the balance of moneys standing to the credit of the Sugar Industry Price Stabilisation Fund as at the 31st day of December, 1953, shall be paid—

(a) as to one-half thereof to the credit of the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund, and

(b) as to the other half thereof to the credit of the Sugar Industry Rehabilitation Fund.

Purposes for
which moneys
transferred
under this
Ordinance
may be applied

3. (1) The moneys transferred under this Ordinance from the Sugar Industry Price Stabilisation Fund to the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund shall be applied by the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund Committee in furtherance of the Housing Loans Scheme for Sugar Workers operated by the said Committee.

(2) The moneys transferred under this Ordinance from the Sugar Industry Price Stabilisation Fund to the Sugar Industry Rehabilitation Fund shall be applied by the Sugar Industry Rehabilitation Fund Committee for purposes of rehabilitation in accordance with regulations made under subsection (1) of section 9 of the Principal Ordinance and for the time being in force.

(3) In this section the expression "Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund Committee" means the Committee appointed under subsection (3) of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance and the expression "Sugar Industry Rehabilitation Fund Committee" means the Committee appointed under subsection (2) of the said section 8.
